Proposed activities include: a review of the school curriculum on SD education for participating schools; seminars, an exhibition and a community fair; training of SD student ambassadors; community service; and the establishment of a website, a resource centre and a VCD on SD.	EPSC members noted that the applicant was a “green school award” winner. They agreed that the community-initiated “bottom-up” approach of the project had strong merit and should be encouraged.

The magazine will be issued every two months, and will be complemented by a website to be monitored and updated regularly.</p> <p>The publication will be distributed free of charge to secondary schools, tertiary educational institutions, public libraries and other outlets.</p>	EPSC Members suggested that the applicant consider reducing the number of issues so as to concentrate more effort on each issue. Members asked that the magazine include coverage of approved SDF projects.
