

Community Sustainable Development Workshop -- Promoting Community Sustainable Development by Women and Youth

The Hong Kong Federation of Women's Centres enables women to develop their confidence, independence and competence. Based on our experience of women-centred services, we believe that women could play a significant role in the sustainable development of the community.

What is the project about?

The project aims to empower women and youth to take an active role in promoting the concept and practice of sustainable development in the Tai Po community. Through a series of events and activities, women and youth are encouraged to participate, lead, serve, collaborate and network in the local community to help develop a lively, people-oriented and sustainable community. The project objectives are:

- To promote the concept and practice of sustainable development in Tai Po at the community level.
- To empower women and youth to become the promoter of community sustainable development in Tai Po.
- To strengthen the Tai Po local residents' sense of belonging and encourage their participation in community affairs as a means of community education and cohesion.
- To make the best use of environmental resources in the community, and to promote local eco-tours and local economic activities.
- To explore with the community stakeholders to establish a sustainable living environment.
- To promote a bottom-up participatory approach to community sustainable development which would enhance public understanding of the relationship between sustainable development and their daily life.

Project Activities

1. A series of talks and workshops will be organised to facilitate the Tai Po local residents, women and youth to understand more about their community environment and resources as well as the concept of sustainable development. Women and youth will be trained as promoters of community sustainable development.
2. Women and youth will conduct "Community Sustainable Development Workshop" and organise various community education programmes to introduce to the community stakeholders the natural and cultural resources in the community, as well as the concept of sustainable development.
3. Through the process of designing a "Checklist for Community Living Environment", community stakeholders are encouraged to express their ideas on the vision of community living environment.
4. The project experience will be concluded, shared and exchanged with the community stakeholders.
