Build an Environmentally Sustainable Society:  
From a Green Network to a Sustainable Community

Baptist Wing Lung Secondary School

Promoting education on sustainable development (SD) has been accorded a high priority in the Baptist Wing Lung Secondary School. The concept and practice of Green School is the theme of our school mission, with a view to cultivating environmental awareness of the students as well as bringing the message of environmental protection to the community. With the grant from the Sustainable Development Fund, we have extended the concept of SD to eight primary schools in the Tuen Mun District and promoted it to the community.

## Project Summary

The main feature of this project is to provide training and education to SD leaders. The trained leaders will then keep promoting what they have learnt from this project to the community. Moreover, an SD network will also be developed in Tuen Mun to provide support to neighboring schools.

## Activities and Progress

### July – September 2004

We carried out evaluations of school-based SD education for eight participating primary schools. Also, we assisted them to set up a green corner and an environmental education resource corner.

### October 2004 – July 2005

On-site teacher training provided to primary school teachers and their students. Related training course materials were designed for primary school students to equip them with the knowledge of environmental protection as well as for onward dissemination.

The Environmental Protection Ambassadors of our school were trained to become SD leaders in the Tuen Mun District. They have been responsible for promoting SD and providing training to primary students to become junior SD leaders as well. Visits to SD facilities were organized for students in order to show them how the concept of SD was put into practice. Various community services were organized for students from the participating schools, in order to put the concept of environmental conservation and community spirit into practice.

A forum "Dialogue with Famous People" was organized in May 2005, inviting distinguished guests such as the Policy Secretary, academics and environmental group leaders to discuss Hong Kong's environment policies and issues with primary and secondary students.

A quiz on SD, environmental protection and health knowledge was held in July 2005 for the primary schools in Tuen Mun, followed by a large-scale exhibition on SD, as well as the production of CD-ROM and website on environmental protection for distribution.

### 31 August 2005 — Project completion

To provide more comprehensive support to the green network, a Life and Environmental Education Centre has been established in our school. We will coordinate with other schools and organizations to establish a green network to better utilize different resources. At the same time, more schools will be encouraged to join the green network to further the development of a sustainable community.
