**Council for Sustainable Development Recognises
Fusion of Sustainable Development and Creativity with
Co-exhibition of Competitions' Winning Entries**

The Council for Sustainable Development (the Council) set the stage for an exhibition of winning entries of the three open competitions under theme of sustainable development concluded in late 2009. Winning entries from the “Sustainable Development” Wall Painting Design Competition, the “Sustainable Built Environment – My Vision” Photo Competition and the “Harmonized Neighbourhood – Sustainable Building Design Model Competition”, will be showcased at the North Atrium, G/F, Olympian City 2 from February 1 – 4, 2010.

About 2,000 entries have been received for the three competitions. The enthusiastic response shows clearly secondary and tertiary students' and the general public's deep commitment and enthusiasm to promote sustainable development in Hong Kong. A co-exhibition on winning entries is organised to let the public appreciate those winning entries, and to enhance the public understanding of sustainable development concept.

The concept of sustainable development is to fully integrate the needs for economic and social development with that to conserve the environment. Since its establishment in 2003, the Council strives to disseminate the message of sustainable development and promote sustainable development concept and practices through the Sustainable Development Fund and the Sustainable Development School Award Programme. The Council also successfully organised the “Sustainable Development” Wall Painting Design Competition in late 2009. All

are welcome to view the winning entries of the champions, which have been painted on the parapet wall at the entrance of Youth Square in Chai Wan.

The Council also encourages the public to discuss and express their views on the major issues of sustainable development in Hong Kong through organization of engagement exercise. In 2009, the Council launched the fourth engagement process with its focus on “Building Design to Foster a Quality and Sustainable Built Environment”. To help young people better understand the subject and actively join in the discussion and express their views on this subject, the Council launched the “Sustainable Built Environment -- My Vision” Photo Competition for Secondary School Students. On the other hand, the Centre of Architectural Research for Education, Elderly, Environment and Excellence and School of Architecture, The Chinese University of Hong Kong co-organised “Harmonized Neighbourhood” - Sustainable Building Design Competition with a view to encouraging tertiary students and graduates to show their creativity in sustainable building design and to better understand the subject.

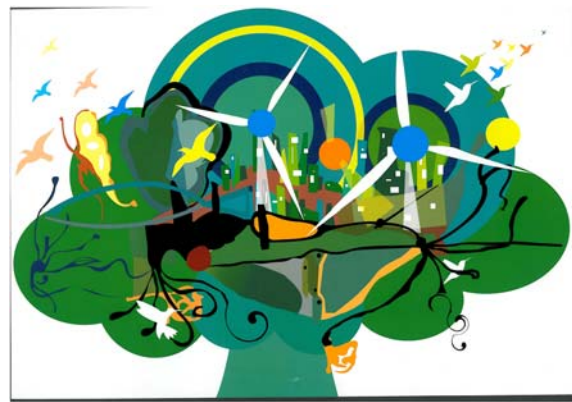
